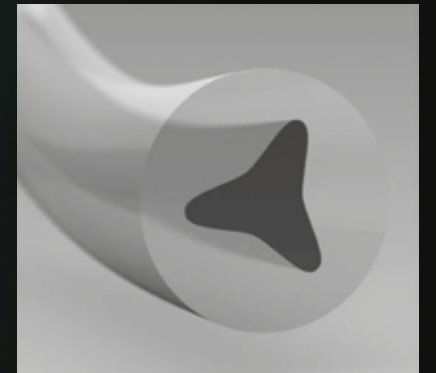
Quality assurance is always extremely important to us. We check our products' properties regularly with specific tests in our laboratory. However, we can also offer verification by an external, independent partner institute.

nega-stat® is introduced into textile materials in a defined grid and stripe patterns to provide optimum protection in a wide range of industrial end-use situations against the risks and hazards caused by static electricity.

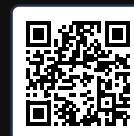
